



Landfill Gas Infrastructure Update

MURFREESBORO, Tenn. (Feb. 28, 2020). Landfills are dynamic, and they require significant resources, continual upkeep and the ability to be nimble as things occur. The same is true for Middle Point Landfill. As a good neighbor and responsible operator, we invest resources when they are needed, and we have the experience to run the site safely and responsibly.

We are aware that some in the community have recently reported odor in the area. To control the potential for off-site odor at Middle Point, our team is taking several steps:

- This week, we began installing additional temporary gas collection infrastructure to send more landfill gas to the on-site flare, where it is safely destroyed;
- Over the next several weeks, our team is installing additional permanent gas collection infrastructure in a targeted 15-acre area. This project will replace the temporary infrastructure and capture even more methane (a byproduct of waste decomposition); and
- We will continue to operate site-wide odor misters and odor neutralizing vaporizers as engineers install this additional gas collection infrastructure.

These steps represent just the latest investment in a series of recent enhancements, totaling more than \$5 million. We remain committed to making further investments as needed.
