



Additional Landfill Gas Infrastructure Planned

MURFREESBORO, Tenn. (Aug. 21, 2020) – We reported earlier this year on several infrastructure projects to collect additional landfill gas and liquids, and to further control the potential for off-site odor from Middle Point Landfill. As part of routine landfill operations and maintenance, our team has begun staging for more landfill enhancements.

In the coming weeks, we will install at least 30 new or replacement landfill gas extraction wells to collect even more landfill gas generated at the site. Each of these wells will include a pump to remove additional landfill liquids and promote more efficient gas collection and control. We expect to begin work on this project next week and complete it by mid-fall. We will keep you updated as we make progress on these efforts.
