Donate

Many local charities can make use of working devices. Two national programs include [Cell Phones for Soldiers](#), which provides free airtime minutes to servicemen and -women, and the [1Million Project](#), which helps connect low-income students to the internet.

Mail back recycling

We make it easy to recycle or dispose of most types of electronics waste – that includes almost anything with a cord. Simply order a prepaid box, fill it up, and mail your electronics back to Republic Services. Boxes can be ordered through Republic Services' Electronics Recycling Mail-Back Program.

Drop off at local collection events
